- 6 publications, and a large collection of materials received by from IOGC.
- 7 Additionally, GuildOne derived supporting materials from a large volume of
- 8 correspondence submitted as exhibits in Samson v. Canada.


- Out of this significant repository, approximately 400+ documents were identified as
- 12 having material value to establishing deficits in the equitable treatment of Enoch as
- 13 an oil and gas producer under Federal management.

MAJOR SOLUTION PHASES



- 3 The process used by GuildOne to create the assessments included in research
- 4 & analysis reports involved five steps that began with high-volume data
- 5 collection followed by human and machine-based document and review, the
- 6 development of assessment models, the application of analytics, and the use
- 7 of advanced visualization tools together with thorough written histories and
- 8 claims research reporting.

9 DISCOVERY

- 10 The Discovery period of this analysis leveraged the full available historical records
- of energy production on and surrounding Enoch lands, including an estimated
- 12 26,000 digitized documents obtained from sources
